**Halloween Happening!** *Fun to be had, and a witches' brew. The only thing we still need is you! Costume parade and contest with prizes, games, snack food!*

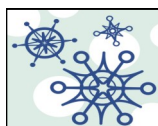

This last winter was a brutal one, as far as snow storms go. We have learned many lessons from the kindness of our neighbors and the way they helped one another, and in true Graylyn Crest spirit, we hope to plan ahead in case we get another snowy winter season.

Please try and move your vehicles off the street when snow is forecast. Our plow contractor will be on the streets when we have over 3" of snow.

If you are unable to park all your vehicles in your garage or driveway, please move them to a remote location, so that the streets may be plowed curb to curb.

If you leave your vehicle on the street during a storm, be prepared to be plowed in.
